





Tunisia88 is a project of 88 educational concerts, focusing on high schools, covering all 24 governorates of Tunisia and presented with the strong belief that music cultivates respect for difference and artists can be global citizens.

Each concert launches a student-led, after-school music club. **Tunisia88 Clubs** plan their own musical events in their communities, participate in songwriting contests, and hold regular weekly meetings. Select members participate in leadership training and the national **Tunisia88 Choir**.

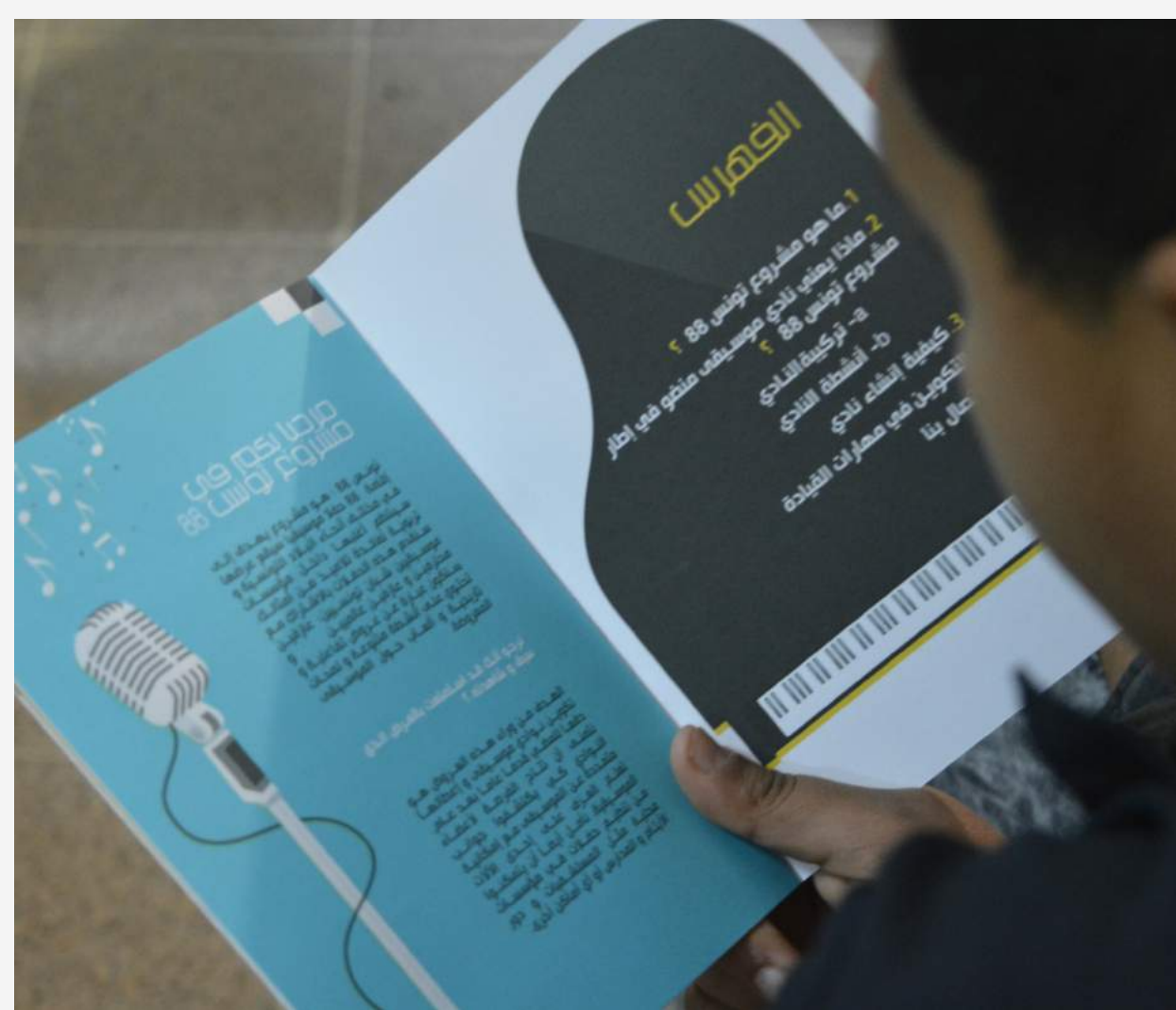
Wherever possible, Tunisia88 commissions and performs music by young Tunisian composers.

Tunisia88 is run in partnership with Action et Développement Solidaire, a Tunisia based NGO; 88 International; and the European Investment Bank Institute. The project is under the 'High Patronage' of the President of the Republic of Tunisia.
